THE SOCIETY OF '67 SCHOLARS TRAVEL AWARD provides an opportunity for medical students and/or residents to familiarize themselves with career opportunities in Pathology and the critical role of Pathology in healthcare delivery, research, and education through access to national leaders in academic Pathology attending the APC 2019 Annual Meeting at the Boston Seaport Hotel and World Trade Center in Boston, MA. The APC 2019 theme focuses on "Innovation through Collective Excellence: Shaping the Future of Pathology."

#### THE 2019 SOCIETY OF '67 SCHOLARS WILL:

- receive an immersive experience in how innovative medical education and practice approaches are being developed in academic pathology;
- understand efforts to communicate the value of pathologists and laboratory medicine to different stakeholders in the health care system and patient communities; and
- interact with the leaders of academic Pathology, bringing a trainee's perspective to the Association, and thus helping to influence the direction of the organization.

- provide a brief report of their experiences (required to receive the travel expense reimbursement); and
