ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be medical students or pathology residents beyond PGY-1 at the time of the APC 2023 Annual Meeting, July 16-19, 2023. Current fourth-year medical students who will be first-year residents (PGY-1) at the time of APC 2023 are not eligible to apply.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION DETAILS:

- For Pathology Resident Applicants: a letter from either their Residency Program Director or their Pathology Department Chair at an APC member department.
- For Medical Student Applicants: a letter from the Pathology Department Chair (APC member department) is preferred, but a letter from a Pathology Faculty Member or Course Director is also acceptable.

The Letter of Recommendation must be submitted no later than the March 1st deadline. The letter can be submitted by the person writing your letter directly to our Awards email (awards@apcprods.org), or if you are given a copy, uploaded into this online application form. Please be sure to have the Chair, Program Director, or Faculty Mentor/Course Director include:
